BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions** 17 2-503. 18 (b) (1) [The] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE 19 Secretary may arrange as the Secretary considers appropriate any benefit option for 20 inclusion in the Program. 21 IN ARRANGING HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT OPTIONS, THE 22 SECRETARY SHALL ENSURE THAT COVERAGE IS PROVIDED FOR A DEPENDENT CHILD 23 OF A STATE EMPLOYEE WHO MUST TAKE A LEAVE OF ABSENCE FROM AN 24 ACCREDITED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION IN ORDER TO FULFILL AN EDUCATIONAL 25 REQUIREMENT OF THE INSTITUTION.
