- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 14 The sales and use tax does not apply to a sale of:
- 15 (1) a Maryland State flag; [or]
- 16 (2) a United States flag; OR
- 17 (3) A PRISONER OF WAR FLAG OR MISSING IN ACTION FLAG HONORING
- 18 AND REMEMBERING MILITARY PERSONNEL WHO HAVE SERVED IN THE ARMED
- 19 FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 July 1, 2000.
