3 FOR the purpose of requiring in Baltimore City a licensed premises to cease all operations after a certain time; authorizing the Board of Liquor License

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
16 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

18 (d) (1) [This] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, THIS section 19 does not apply to premises conducted on New Year's Day by on-sale licensees in 20 Baltimore City.

- 1 (2) IN BALTIMORE CITY, A LICENSED PREMISES SHALL CEASE ALL
- 2 OPERATIONS, INCLUDING THE SERVING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR FOOD AND
- 3 PROVIDING ENTERTAINMENT, AT THE CLOSING HOUR FOR THAT CLASS OF LICENSED
- 4 PREMISES SPECIFIED IN THIS ARTICLE.
- 5 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE
- 6 BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY GRANT AN EXEMPTION FOR
- 7 REMAINING OPEN AFTER HOURS TO:
- 8 (I) A HOLDER OF A CLASS B RESTAURANT LICENSE, ONLY FOR
- 9 SERVING FOOD TO SEATED PATRONS; OR
- 10 (II) A PHARMACY THAT FILLS PRESCRIPTIONS.
- 11 (4) A PHARMACY THAT RECEIVES AN EXEMPTION UNDER PARAGRAPH (3)
- 12 OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY ALSO SELL PRODUCTS OTHER THAN ALCOHOL AFTER
- 13 NORMAL CLOSING HOURS.
- 14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 15 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety,
- 16 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 17 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 18 the date it is enacted.
