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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## Creation of a State Debt - Harford County - Ripken Museum

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the
- 5 Ripken Museum, Inc. for certain development or improvement purposes;
- 6 providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that
- 7 the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for
- 8 the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

## 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

10 MARYLAND, That:

- 11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Harford
- 13 County Ripken Museum Loan of 2000 in the total principal amount of \$200,000.
- 14 This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general
- 15 obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued,
- 16 sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance
- 17 and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 18 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 19 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 20 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 21 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 22 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 23 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 24 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 25 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 26 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Ripken
- 27 Museum, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the acquisition of
- 28 a building at 11 West Belair Avenue in Aberdeen, the building to be used as a
- 29 museum, for administrative offices, and for the storage of memorabilia.
- 30 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 31 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and

- 1 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 2 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 3 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 4 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the Mayor and City Council of the City of
- 5 Aberdeen shall provide and expend a matching fund of \$100,000; and the County
- 6 Executive and County Council of Harford County shall provide a matching fund of
- 7 \$25,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly or
- 8 indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part
- 9 of the fund may consist of in kind contributions or funds expended prior to the
- 10 effective date of this Act. The matching fund may consist of real property. In case of
- 11 any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may
- 12 qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and
- 13 the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2002, to present evidence
- 14 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If
- 15 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State
- 16 Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in
- 17 this Act.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 June 1, 2000.
