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### Chapter 116 of the Acts of 1995

- 2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Certification Agency,
- 3 in consultation with the General Assembly AND THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY
- 4 GENERAL, shall initiate a study of the Minority Business Enterprise Program to
- 5 evaluate the Program's continued compliance with the requirements of the Croson
- 6 decision and any subsequent federal or constitutional requirements. The study shall
- 7 also evaluate race neutral programs and other methods that can be used to address
- 8 the needs of minority businesses. An executive summary of the study shall be
- 9 submitted to the Legislative Policy Committee of the General Assembly by December
- 10 1. 2000: AN EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF THE STUDY SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE
- 11 LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY DECEMBER 1,
- 12 2000. The final report on the study shall be submitted to the Legislative Policy
- 13 Committee of the General Assembly prior to September 30, [1999] 2000 January 3
- 14 JANUARY 10, 2001 so that the General Assembly may review the report prior to
- 15 *DURING* the [2000] 2001 Session.
- 16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 July 1, 2000.
