2 3	Nurse Psychotherapists - Authority to Prescribe Medications in Pro Bono
3	Programs Not Adequately Served by Physician Volunteers
4	FOR the purpose of authorizing a nurse psychotherapist to prescribe certain
5	medications for certain individuals if the nurse psychotherapist meets certain
6	educational requirements and, with a certain physician and certain program,
7	enters into a certain written agreement that is approved by the State Board of
8	Nursing; requiring a nurse psychotherapist to notify the Board immediately if a
9	certain agreement is terminated and to obtain the approval of the Board of a
10	new or amended agreement; prohibiting the Board from approving a certain
11	agreement unless the Board of Physician Quality Assurance reviews and
12	approves the role of a certain physician; requiring the Board and the State
13	Board of Physician Quality Assurance to establish a joint committee to make
14	certain recommendations concerning certain written agreements; providing for
15	the composition of a certain joint committee; requiring the Board to adopt
16	certain regulations jointly with the State Board of Physician Quality Assurance;
17	requiring the Board, in consultation with the State Board of Pharmacy, to
18	develop a certain formulary jointly with the State Board of Physician Quality
19	Assurance; providing that this Act does not affect certain authority of a nurse
20	psychotherapist; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the authority
21	of certain nurse psychotherapists to prescribe certain medications.

 THE NURSE PSYCHOTHERAPIST IN PERIODICALLY REVIEWING AND DISCUSSING THE
 MENTAL HEALTH DIAGNOSIS, DOCUMENTATION, AND THE THERAPEUTIC OR
 CORRECTIVE MEASURES BEING EMPLOYED IN THE TREATMENT BY THE NURSE
 PSYCHOTHERAPIST OF A PROGRAM PATIENT FOR WHOM THE NURSE
 PSYCHOTHERAPIST PRESCRIBES OR PROPOSES TO PRESCRIBE A MEDICATION; AND

(VII) A REQUIREMENT THAT THE PHYSICIAN OR A PHYSICIAN
 DESIGNEE OF THE PHYSICIAN BE AVAILABLE FOR CONSULTATION IN PERSON, BY
 TELEPHONE, OR THROUGH SOME OTHER FORM OF TELECOMMUNICATION AND THAT
 THE PHYSICIAN AND DESIGNEE ACCEPT REFERRALS.

(D) BEFORE PRESCRIBING A MEDICATION, A NURSE PSYCHOTHERAPIST
SHALL BE REGISTERED WITH THE UNITED STATES DRUG ENFORCEMENT AGENCY AS
AN AUTHORIZED PRESCRIBER.

(E) IF A WRITTEN PRESCRIBING AGREEMENT IS TERMINATED BY THE NURSE
PSYCHOTHERAPIST, THE PHYSICIAN, OR THE PROGRAM, THE NURSE
PSYCHOTHERAPIST IMMEDIATELY SHALL ADVISE THE BOARD AND OBTAIN THE
BOARD'S APPROVAL OF A NEW OR AMENDED WRITTEN PRESCRIBING AGREEMENT.

32 (F) THE BOARD MAY NOT APPROVE A WRITTEN PRESCRIBING AGREEMENT
33 UNDER THIS SECTION UNLESS THE BOARD OF PHYSICIAN QUALITY ASSURANCE
34 REVIEWS AND APPROVES THE ROLE OF THE PHYSICIAN AS ESTABLISHED IN THE
35 WRITTEN PRESCRIBING AGREEMENT.

36 (G) (1) THE BOARD AND THE BOARD OF PHYSICIAN QUALITY ASSURANCE
37 SHALL ESTABLISH A JOINT COMMITTEE TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE
38 BOARD AND TO THE BOARD OF PHYSICIAN QUALITY ASSURANCE CONCERNING
39 WRITTEN PRESCRIBING AGREEMENTS SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD FOR APPROVAL

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(2) THE JOINT COMMITTEE SHALL BE COMPOSED OF AN EQUAL
 NUMBER OF MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE BOARD AND THE BOARD OF PHYSICIAN
 QUALITY ASSURANCE.

4 (H) THE BOARD SHALL:

5 (1) ADOPT REGULATIONS JOINTLY WITH THE BOARD OF PHYSICIAN 6 QUALITY ASSURANCE TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION; AND

7 (2) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY,
8 DEVELOP JOINTLY WITH THE STATE BOARD OF PHYSICIAN QUALITY ASSURANCE A
9 FORMULARY OF SCHEDULE II, III, IV, AND V MEDICATIONS OR CLASSES OF
10 MEDICATIONS THAT A NURSE PSYCHOTHERAPIST MAY PRESCRIBE WITHIN THE
11 AUTHORITY CONFERRED BY THE WRITTEN PRESCRIBING AGREEMENT.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2000.
