A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Caterer Privilege

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners
- 4 to add a certain caterer privilege to certain alcoholic beverages licenses;
- 5 authorizing a licensee who holds a caterer privilege to contract to provide
- 6 certain services; establishing the hours that a licensee may exercise a caterer
- 7 privilege; requiring a licensee who holds a caterer privilege to have certain
- 8 facilities; providing that a caterer privilege is incorporated into the existing
- 9 license; establishing a certain annual fee for a caterer privilege; providing for
- renewal of a caterer privilege; defining a certain term; and generally relating to
- adding a certain caterer privilege to certain alcoholic beverages licenses in
- 12 Baltimore City.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 21 6-701.1.
- 22 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY.
- 23 (B) IN THIS SECTION, "CATERER" MEANS ANY BEER AND WINE OR BEER, WINE
- 24 AND LIOUOR LICENSEE WHO CONTRACTS TO PROVIDE FOOD AND ALCOHOLIC
- 25 BEVERAGES TO SPONSORS OF PUBLIC OR PRIVATE EVENTS HELD OFF THE LICENSED
- 26 PREMISES.

- 1 (C) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ADD A SPECIAL OFF-SALE 2 CATERER PRIVILEGE FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING A LICENSEE TO BE A 3 CATERER.
- 4 (D) A LICENSEE WHO HOLDS THE SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE 5 MAY CONTRACT TO PROVIDE FOOD AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION 6 AT A CATERED EVENT.
- 7 (E) THE LICENSEE MAY EXERCISE THE SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER 8 PRIVILEGE ONLY DURING THE HOURS AND DAYS THAT ARE PERMITTED UNDER THIS 9 ARTICLE FOR THE EXISTING BEER AND WINE OR BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 10 (F) (1) A LICENSEE WHO HOLDS A SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE 11 SHALL HAVE THE FACILITIES TO PREPARE AND DELIVER FOOD TO THE SITE OF THE 12 CATERED EVENT.
- 13 (2) THE BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT SHALL APPROVE THE 14 FOOD PREPARATION FACILITIES AND ISSUE A CATERER'S LICENSE BEFORE THE 15 BOARD ADDS OR RENEWS A SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE.
- 16 (G) A SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE IS NOT A SEPARATE CLASS OF LICENSE AND, IF IT IS GRANTED, THE PRIVILEGE IS INCORPORATED WITHIN THE 8 EXISTING ON-SALE BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 19 (H) THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE IS 20 \$500 IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE EXISTING BEER AND WINE OR BEER, 21 WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 22 (I) A SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE MAY BE RENEWED.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 2000.
