## 2 Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Caterer Privilege

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners
- to add a certain caterer privilege to certain alcoholic beverages licenses; 4
- authorizing a licensee who holds a caterer privilege to contract to provide 5
- certain services; establishing the hours that a licensee may exercise a caterer 6
- privilege; requiring a licensee who holds a caterer privilege to have certain 7
- 8 facilities; providing that a caterer privilege is incorporated into the existing
- 9 license; establishing a certain annual fee for a caterer privilege; providing for
- 10 renewal of a caterer privilege; defining a certain term; and generally relating to
- adding a certain caterer privilege to certain alcoholic beverages licenses in 11

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
- 21 6-701.1.
- 22 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY.

- 1 (B) IN THIS SECTION, "CATERER" MEANS ANY BEER AND WINE OR BEER, WINE
- 2 AND LIQUOR LICENSEE WHO CONTRACTS TO PROVIDE FOOD AND ALCOHOLIC
- 3 BEVERAGES TO SPONSORS OF PUBLIC OR PRIVATE EVENTS HELD OFF THE LICENSED
- 4 PREMISES.
- 5 (C) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ADD A SPECIAL OFF-SALE
- 6 CATERER PRIVILEGE FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING A LICENSEE TO BE A
- 7 CATERER.
- 8 (D) A LICENSEE WHO HOLDS THE SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE
- 9 MAY CONTRACT TO PROVIDE FOOD AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION
- 10 AT A CATERED EVENT.
- 11 (E) THE LICENSEE MAY EXERCISE THE SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER
- 12 PRIVILEGE ONLY DURING THE HOURS AND DAYS THAT ARE PERMITTED UNDER THIS
- 13 ARTICLE FOR THE EXISTING BEER AND WINE OR BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 14 (F) (1) A LICENSEE WHO HOLDS A SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE
- 15 SHALL HAVE THE FACILITIES TO PREPARE AND DELIVER FOOD TO THE SITE OF THE
- 16 CATERED EVENT.
- 17 (2) THE BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT SHALL APPROVE THE
- 18 FOOD PREPARATION FACILITIES AND ISSUE A CATERER'S LICENSE BEFORE THE
- 19 BOARD ADDS OR RENEWS A SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE.
- 20 (G) A SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE IS NOT A SEPARATE CLASS OF
- 21 LICENSE AND, IF IT IS GRANTED, THE PRIVILEGE IS INCORPORATED WITHIN THE
- 22 EXISTING ON-SALE BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 23 (H) THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE IS
- 24 \$500 IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE EXISTING BEER AND WINE OR BEER,
- 25 WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 26 (I) A SPECIAL OFF-SALE CATERER PRIVILEGE MAY BE RENEWED.
- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 28 October 1, 2000.
