- 20 (a) (1) A Class B beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued by the license
- 21 issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located, and the
- 22 license authorizes its holder to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at retail
- 23 at any hotel or restaurant at the place described, for consumption on the premises or
- 24 elsewhere, or as provided in this section.
- 25 (2) The annual fee for this license is payable to the local collecting agent
- 26 before any license is issued, for distribution as provided in this article.
- 27 (d) (1) (i) This subsection applies only in Baltimore City.

- THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR A RESTAURANT WITH A 6 3. 7 CAPACITY FOR DINING OF OVER 300 PERSONS, AS DETERMINED BY THE BALTIMORE 8 CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT, IS \$3,500.
