1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Class B License Fees**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the annual license fee in Baltimore City for certain Class  
4 B beer, wine and liquor licenses; and generally relating to annual license fees for  
5 Class B beer, wine and liquor licenses in Baltimore City.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

19 6-201.

20 (a) (1) A Class B beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued by the license  
21 issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located, and the  
22 license authorizes its holder to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at retail  
23 at any hotel or restaurant at the place described, for consumption on the premises or  
24 elsewhere, or as provided in this section.

25 (2) The annual fee for this license is payable to the local collecting agent  
26 before any license is issued, for distribution as provided in this article.

27 (d) (1) (i) This subsection applies only in Baltimore City.
