- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Agriculture to pay a farmer eligible
- 4 to participate in the Federal Crop Insurance Program a certain amount of
- 5 money for Federal Crop Insurance premiums paid; authorizing for moneys

- 20 (A) THERE IS A MARYLAND CROP INSURANCE PREMIUM PROGRAM WHICH IS
- 21 ESTABLISHED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENCOURAGING ELIGIBLE FARMERS TO
- 22 PARTICIPATE IN THE FEDERAL CROP INSURANCE PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE
- 23 UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.
- 24 (B) (1) THE SECRETARY MAY PAY A FARMER ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN
- 25 THE FEDERAL CROP INSURANCE PROGRAM NOT MORE THAN \$2 PER ACRE FOR ANY
- 26 FEDERAL CROP INSURANCE PREMIUM PAID BY THE FARMER.

- 1 (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY DISTRIBUTE MONEY UNDER THE MARYLAND 2 CROP INSURANCE PREMIUM PROGRAM FROM FUNDS PROVIDED IN THE BUDGET.
- 3 (C) THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 4 PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 2000.
