- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Agriculture to pay a farmer eligible
- 4 to participate in the Federal Crop Insurance Program a certain amount of
- 5 money for Federal Crop Insurance premiums paid; authorizing for moneys
- 6 provided under the Program to be distributed from a certain source; authorizing

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 2 SUBTITLE 9. MARYLAND CROP INSURANCE PREMIUM PROGRAM.
- 3 2-901.
- 4 (A) THERE IS A MARYLAND CROP INSURANCE PREMIUM PROGRAM WHICH IS
- 5 ESTABLISHED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENCOURAGING ELIGIBLE FARMERS TO
- 6 PARTICIPATE IN THE FEDERAL CROP INSURANCE PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE
- 7 UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.
- 8 (B) (1) THE SECRETARY MAY PAY A FARMER ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN
- 9 THE FEDERAL CROP INSURANCE PROGRAM NOT MORE THAN \$2 PER ACRE FOR ANY
- 10 FEDERAL CROP INSURANCE PREMIUM PAID BY THE FARMER.
- 11 (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY DISTRIBUTE MONEY UNDER THE MARYLAND
- 12 CROP INSURANCE PREMIUM PROGRAM FROM FUNDS PROVIDED IN THE BUDGET.
- 13 (C) THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE
- 14 PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2000.
