- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 16 Article 83A - Department of Business and Economic Development

- 18 (a) There is a Maryland Tourism Development Board Fund.
- 19 (b) The Fund is established to provide a continuing fund for the Board to fund
- 20 programs relating to the planning, advertising, promotion, assistance, and
- 21 development of the tourism industry in the State.
- 22 (c) The Fund is a special, continuous, nonlapsing fund that is not subject to §
- 23 7-302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 24 (d) The Treasurer shall invest and reinvest the Fund in the same manner as
- 25 other State funds and credit any investment earnings to the General Fund.
