AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 3 OF THIS ACT, the standards enacted under this Act shall be applicable to a data collection form that is created or revised after the effective date of this Act, and the standards shall be applicable to all data collection forms no later than January 1, 2002.						

32 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THE STANDARDS SHALL 33 BE APPLICABLE TO ALL DATA COLLECTION FORMS FOR SCHOOLS, SCHOOL SYSTEMS, 34 AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION NO LATER THAN JULY 1, 2003.
