House Bill 1090 (Delegate Montague. *et al.*)

Judiciary

Juvenile Justice - Criminal Justice Information System - Dissemination of Information

This bill requires the Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) central repository to disseminate on a monthly basis non-identifying information concerning a child charged as an adult to the Maryland Justice Analysis Center of the Institute of Criminal Justice and Criminology of the University of Maryland, including the age, race, and gender of the child.

The Maryland Justice Analysis Center must analyze the information and report its results to the Governor and General Assembly by June 30 and December 31 of each year.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services (DPSCS) expenditures would increase by \$2,000 in FY 2001 for computer programming.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The CJIS central repository is not statutorily required to disseminate information to the Maryland Justice Analysis Center.

State Fiscal Effect: The bill would require the alteration of computer programming for CJIS at an estimated cost of \$2,000. The monthly cost of issuing reports to the Maryland Justice Analysis Center could be absorbed by DPSCS using existing budgeted resources.

The Maryland Justice Analysis Center could prepare and provide the required reports using existing budgeted resources.
