Appropriations

Prince George's County - Prohibited Funding or Permits for Highway Projects PG 402-00

This bill prohibits the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) from acquiring additional rights-of-way or spending any funds for the design or construction, in Prince George's County, of the proposed: (1) intercounty connector; (2) the Washington bypass; or (3) highway designated as highway A-58.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. There are no planned expenditures for the projects identified in the proposed legislation beyond FY 2000.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

State Expenditures: According to the Maryland Consolidated Transportation Program (CTP) for fiscal 2000 through 2005, MDOT has budgeted \$900,000 in fiscal 2000 to purchase rights-of-way for the proposed intercounty connector highway project. There are no funds programmed for the project beyond fiscal 2000. It is estimated that to date, a total of \$62,077,000 in special funds and \$10,329,000 in federal funds have been expended for planning, engineering, and right-of-way acquisition. No funds are included in the draft CTP for the Washington bypass or the proposed highway designated as A-58.
