House Bill 1260 (Delegate Moe)

Commerce and Government Matters

Passenger Railroad Services - Bicycles - Transport

This bill requires the Mass Transit Administration (MTA) to adopt regulations to facilitate the transportation of bicycles on board passenger railroad services.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill is not expected to significantly affect State finances or operations.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: None applicable. However, MTA policy allows bicycles on the Light Rail and Baltimore Metro subway systems except for two hours before and after specified sporting events. Further, collapsible bicycles are allowed on Maryland Rail Commuter (MARC) trains.
