Senate Bill 620 (Senator Sfikas)

Economic and Environmental Affairs

Electricians - Providing Electrical Services Without a Permit - Penalties

The bill authorizes the State Board of Electricians or the local electrical board to impose a civil penalty not to exceed \$1,000 on any person who provides electrical services in an unlicensed local jurisdiction without first obtaining any permits required by the jurisdiction. The bill provides guidelines for setting the penalty amount.
