Senate Joint Resolution 10 (Senator Stone. *et al.*) Finance

Employees' Right to Organize

This joint resolution calls on all employers not to inhibit through coercion or intimidation their employees' opportunity to join a union. It further calls on employers to abide by their employees' decision to be represented by a union by engaging in card-check elections and thereby avoiding the delays that accompany the election processes of the National Labor Relations Board.
