### Vehicle Laws - Unattended Motor Vehicle - Private Property

This bill provides that the prohibition against leaving a vehicle unattended until the engine is stopped, the ignition is locked, the key is removed, and the brake is effectively set does not apply when a vehicle is locked and on private property.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Since the bill would apply in a limited number of cases, State finances would not be affected. There were three violations of the current prohibition in FY 1999.

## **Analysis**

**Current Law:** An individual may not leave a vehicle unattended until the engine is stopped, the ignition is locked, the key is removed, and the brake is effectively set.
