Anne Arundel County - Charitable Gaming Events

This bill repeals a prohibition against conducting a charitable casino event in Anne Arundel County.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Anne Arundel County revenues would increase by approximately \$1,250 annually beginning in FY 2001. No effect on expenditures.

Small Business Effect: Minimal impact on a few nonprofit organizations.

Analysis

Current Law: A person may not conduct a casino event in Anne Arundel County.

Local Fiscal Effect: Anne Arundel County advises that it would issue approximately 25 gaming licenses at a cost of \$50 each for persons holding charitable gaming events. As a result, revenues would increase by \$1,250 each year.
