House Bill 1112 (Frederick County Delegation and Baltimore County Delegation)
Economic Matters

Frederick County and Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages - Light Wine Licenses

This bill allows Class A (off-sale) light wine licensees in Baltimore and Frederick counties to sell wines with up to 21% alcohol by volume.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. The licensing fee for Class A light wine licenses is not altered.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Analysis

Current Law: Class A light wine licenses are issued to holders of State Class 4 limited winery licenses. In Baltimore and Frederick counties, the Class A license only allows the winery to sell products with up to 14% alcohol by volume.
