FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 453 (St. Mary's County Delegation)

Economic Matters

St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverages - License Renewal

This bill requires alcoholic beverage licensees in St. Mary's County to apply for renewal of licenses from February 1 through March 3 or have their license expire as of April 30 of the year for which the license was not renewed. The holder of an expired license must reapply to the county Alcoholic Beverages Board.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. The bill codifies existing practice in St. Mary's County.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Though it is not the practice in St. Mary's County, licensees are required by Maryland law to submit license renewal applications not less than 30 nor more than 60 days prior to May 1. Renewal applications must state that the facts in the original application are unchanged. There is no application fee for an alcoholic beverages license in St. Mary's County.
