House Bill 1383 (Delegate C. Davis)

Economic Matters

Baltimore City - Board of Liquor License Commissioners - Salaries

This bill increases the salaries paid to the members of the Board of Liquor License Commissioners of Baltimore City. The chairman will receive \$25,000 per year and the other two members will receive \$24,500.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Baltimore City pays the salaries of the members of the Board of Liquor License Commissioners.

Local Effect: Baltimore City expenditures would increase by \$19,500 annually beginning in FY 2002.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The Chairman of the Board of Liquor License Commissioners of Baltimore City has an annual salary of \$18,500 and other members receive salaries of \$18,000.

Local Expenditures: The salary increases take effect on July 1, 2001, the beginning of the next term of office for the Board of Liquor License Commissioners. There are three members of the board, each of whom will receive an additional \$6,500 per year, starting in fiscal 2002. The total increase is \$19,500 per year. Board members do not receive benefits.
