Baltimore City - King Memorial Child Care Family Center Loan of 1998

This bill extends the deadline from June 1, 2000, to June 1, 2002, for the King Memorial Child Care Family Center to provide matching funds of up to \$150,000 for the King Memorial Child Care Family Center Loan of 1998.

The bill is effective June 1, 2000.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Extending the deadline for the provision of the matching funds would not directly affect State finances.

Local Effect: None. Baltimore City does not provide funding for this project in its capital plan.

Small Business Effect: Minimal effect on one small non-profit entity.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 199 of 1998 authorized up to \$150,000 in matching funds for the planning, design, repair, renovation, capital equipping, and furnishing of a building to be used as a full-time professional child care center.

Background: The King Memorial Child Care Family Center is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing professional, non-sectarian child care and family services to the immediate and surrounding communities in Baltimore City.

The amount of private funds and pledges raised for the project to date is \$75,000.
