**Health Insurance - Task Force to Study the Non-Group Health Insurance Market -
Repeal**

This bill repeals current law that establishes a task force to study the non-group health insurance market.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill would not materially affect governmental finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 602 of 1999 established a 14-member task force to study the non-group health insurance market. The task force reviews and studies the characteristics of the non-group market, including the affordability of non-group products, the demographics of those insured in the non-group market, and an analysis and survey of non-group products available in Maryland. The task force is to submit a final report on its findings to the Governor and the General Assembly on December 15, 2000.
