### **Charles County - Firearms - Regulation**

This bill prohibits a person from discharging a "firearm" within 500 feet of specified structures or places (e.g., homes, churches, schools) in Charles County. Violators are guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a maximum fine of \$500.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** General fund revenues could increase minimally under the bill's monetary penalty provision since these cases would be heard in the District Court.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

## **Analysis**

**Current Law:** An existing prohibition applies only to the discharge of air guns, with the same maximum monetary penalty attached.
