Economic Matters

Property and Casualty Insurance - Flood Insurance - Communications to Property Owners by Insurers

This bill prohibits insurers from sending a communication, directly or through an agent, to a property owner offering to provide flood insurance unless the property owner resides within an area identified as a Zone A or Zone B area on a current flood insurance rate map published by the Federal Emergency Management Agency. The bill applies only to communications by computer on-line transmission, facsimile, letter or other form of written communication, telegraph, or telephone.
