# FISCAL NOTE Revised

House Bill 1064 (Montgomerv County Delegation) Ways and Means

#### Montgomery County - Board of Education - Public Hearings on Transportation of Students

This bill requires the Montgomery County Board of Education to hold a public hearing on an appeal of the school superintendent's denial of an appeal of a decision by the school system's chief operating officer to add or delete a school bus stop or to eliminate or move a school bus route. Members of the public must be given a reasonable opportunity to testify and the board of education must make its decision publicly with each member's vote recorded.

## **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** Any costs associated with additional public hearings are assumed to be minimal and absorbable within existing budgeted resources.

Small Business Effect: None.

## Analysis

**Current Law:** There are no statutory requirements that consideration of appeals must take place in a public hearing. The only legal requirements for public hearings on education matters statewide involve the expulsion or long-term suspension of students and the dismissal of certain professional employees.
