FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 1244 (Montgomery County Delegation)
Ways and Means

Montgomery County - Education - Home and Hospital Teacher Representation
MC 3-00

This bill expands the definition of public school employee in Montgomery County to include specified home and hospital teachers for the purpose of being represented by the employee organization for certificated school employees. In addition, the bill stipulates that a home or hospital teacher who works on a short-term day-to-day basis is not required to pay a service or representation fee.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2000.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Any effect on payroll costs resulting from expanding the number of school employees in Montgomery County that are represented by the certificated school employee organization cannot be reliably estimated at this time.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Home and hospital teachers in Montgomery County are not considered to be certificated school employees.
