This bill requires the Governor each year to issue a proclamation encouraging the citizens of the State of Maryland, the media, governmental departments and agencies, and business and recreational facilities to observe a moment of silence at 3:00 p.m. on Memorial Day to unite in remembrance and commemorate the heroic acts and efforts of Marylanders who have served and died in the armed forces.
