House Bill 415 (Delegate Kagan. *et al.*)

Ways and Means

Education - Public School Holidays - Presidents' Day

This bill establishes Presidents' Day as a public school holiday.

This bill takes effect July 1, 2000.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Adding an additional holiday to the public school calendar will not alter the number of days that schools are required to remain in session.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The State has designated several days as public school holidays. They include the following:

- Thanksgiving Day and the day after;
 - Christmas Eve through January 1;
 - Martin Luther King, Jr. Day;
 - Good Friday and Easter Monday;
 - Memorial Day; and
 - Primary and general election days.
