Ways and Means

Community College of Baltimore County - Board of Trustees and Chancellor -
Delegation of Authority

This bill enables the Board of Trustees of the Community College of Baltimore County to authorize the Chancellor, by resolution, to sign legal documents on behalf of the board, including documents related to the disposition of assets or property of the community college. The resolution may authorize the Chancellor to delegate this authority.

This bill takes effect July 1, 2000.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Enabling the Chancellor of the Community College of Baltimore County to perform certain tasks would not affect Baltimore County finances.

Current Law: The board of trustees may authorize the Chancellor to execute a conveyance or other legal document.
