Garrett County - Marriage License Fee

This bill permits the Board of County Commissioners of Garrett County to set an additional marriage license fee of up to \$40 to fund domestic violence programs.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2000.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Garrett County would receive a maximum of \$35,000 annually to fund domestic violence programs.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The basic statewide fee for a marriage license is \$10, of which \$5 is retained by the clerk of the circuit court and \$5 goes to the county general fund. In many counties (not including Garrett County), an additional fee is authorized to fund domestic violence programs.

Local Revenues: Garrett County advises that in recent years approximately 850 to 900 couples obtain marriage licenses in Garrett County annually. At that rate, Garrett County would receive approximately \$35,000 to fund domestic violence programs pursuant to the bill, assuming that the maximum additional fee of \$40 is charged. Garrett County further advises, however, that it anticipates a drop in the number of marriage license applications due

to a recent change in West Virginia law.
