House Bill 1335 (Delegates Moe and Tavlor) Commerce and Government Matters

Millennium - One Maryland Monument Commission

The bill establishes a Millennium - One Maryland Monument Commission to develop recommendations for the design, construction, and placement of a suitable monument on the State House grounds that would contain a space for each county and Baltimore City to depict a representative aspect of its culture.

The commission shall submit a report to the Governor to the General Assembly on or before December 1, 2000. The Governor is required to include at least \$150,000 in the fiscal 2002 State budget for the design, construction, and placement of the monument.

The bill is effective June 1, 2000.
