Police Training Commission - Police Officer - Definition

This bill adds the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation Police Force to the definition of police officer under provisions relating to the Police Training Commission.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Minimal. The Police Training Commission already certifies the police officers of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation (DLLR) Police Force. The 16 members of DLLR's police force will continue to perform duties relating to building and agency security in facilities housing DLLR operations which are not managed by the Department of General Services. However, DLLR would experience a savings of approximately \$1,200 in handgun permit renewal fees every three years since this bill would eliminate the need for handgun permits for the police force. The Department of State Police would also experience an equal amount of lost revenue every three years.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Provisions relating to the Police Training Commission define "police officer" to mean members of various specified State and local government agencies. DLLR police officers are not included.
