Montgomery County - Joseph White House Loan of 1998

This bill changes the grantee for the Joseph White House Loan of 1998 from the Board of Directors of the Parks Foundation, Inc. to the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC). The bill extends the deadline, from June 1, 2000 to June 1, 2001, for the provision of matching funds by the grantee.

The bill is effective June 1, 2000.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Changing the grantee and extending the matching fund deadline would not directly affect State finances.

Local Effect: Minimal impact on M-NCPPC.

Small Business Effect None.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 304 of 1998 authorized up to \$200,000, in matching funds, for the planning, design, repair, renovation, restoration, and capital equipping of the historic Joseph White House located in Boyds, Maryland.

Background: M-NCPPC holds title to the Rickman Farm, where the house is located, and is in a better financial position to care for the property.
