House Bill 436 (Carroll County Delegation)

Commerce and Government Matters

#### Carroll County - Recodification of the Code of Public Laws

This bill recodifies the Public Local Laws of Carroll County, updating language without substantively changing the local laws, and repeals the sections of public local laws that deal with Carroll County municipalities. In addition, the bill authorizes the County Commissioners of Carroll County to make an appropriation to provide for the publication, sale, and distribution of the 2000 Edition of the Carroll County Code of Public Local Laws.

## **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** The bill makes no substantive changes to current law. It is assumed that any expenditures made to print and publish the Carroll County Code of Pubic Laws would be recouped by the revenues gained from their sale.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

## **Analysis**

**Current Law:** Aside from the repeal of municipal code, the bill only makes stylistic changes to current law.

**Background:** Municipalities in Carroll County maintain their own codes of public local laws, and the county code has not updated municipal codes as they have been amended. For that reason, Carroll County is dropping municipal code from its county code.
