### **Alcoholic Beverages - Class A Licensees - Lottery Ticket Terminal Operators**

This bill permits a person 18 years of age or older to operate a lottery ticket terminal at a licensed Class A alcoholic beverages distributor.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. The bill would not directly affect governmental finances.

**Local Effect:** None.

Small Business Effect: Potential minimal.

# **Analysis**

**Current Law:** The laws regarding the age at which individuals are permitted to perform different tasks at Class A licensed establishments vary from county to county. No current provisions designate an age at which an individual working for or hired by a Class A licensee may operate a lottery ticket terminal. Regardless of the venue, a person under the age of 18 may not buy, sell, or cash lottery tickets.
