FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 117 (Howard County Delegation)
Ways and Means

Howard County - Board of Education - Compensation
Ho. Co. 8-00

This bill increases the salaries of the members of the Howard County Board of Education. The chairman's salary is increased from \$11,000 to \$14,000 and the other members' salaries are increased from \$9,900 to \$12,000.

This bill takes effect July 1, 2000.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Howard County expenditures increase by \$12,300 annually beginning in FY 2001. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Salaries for the five members of the Howard County Board of Education are \$11,000 for the chairman and \$9,900 for the other members.

Background: Pursuant to Chapter 71 of 1996, board members received a salary increase in fiscal 1997 (\$3,200 increase for the chairman and a \$3,000 increase for the other members). Pursuant to Chapter 42 of 1998, board members also received a salary increase in fiscal 1999 (\$1,000 increase for the chairman and a \$900 increase for the other members).

Local Fiscal Effect: The Howard County Board of Education has five members elected for six-year terms. This bill would increase Howard County expenditures by \$12,272 annually (\$11,400 in salaries and \$872 in Social Security taxes) beginning in fiscal 2001.
