FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 1047 (Delegate Hubbard. *et al.*)

Environmental Matters

State Board of Nursing - Probationary License

This bill allows the Board of Nursing to grant a probationary license to an applicant in any circumstance in which the board may deny a license to an applicant.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill's requirements would not materially affect governmental finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The board may deny a license to an applicant for any reason listed under Section 8-316 of the Health Occupations Article.

State Fiscal Effect: The Board of Nursing advises that the probationary license may be given to approximately 6-10 applicants. Applicants pay an application fee regardless of whether a license is issued, so there is no fiscal impact associated with issuing probationary licenses.
