Wicomico County - Liquor Control Board - Salaries

---

This bill increases the compensation of the members of the Wicomico County Liquor Control Board. The chairman of the board will receive \$3,500 per year and the other members will receive \$2,750 per year.

---

Fiscal Summary

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Wicomico County expenditures would increase by \$2,500 annually beginning in FY 2002 due to increases in the compensation rates of Liquor Control Board members.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

---

Analysis

**Current Law:** The chairman of the Wicomico County Liquor Control Board receives \$2,500 per year and other members receive \$2,000. Alterations to the salaries of board members take effect at the beginning of the next term of office. The next term of office begins July 1, 2001.

**Local Expenditures:** The annual compensation rate for the Chairman of the Wicomico County Liquor Control Board would increase by \$1,000 and the rate for the two other board members would increase by \$750. Wicomico County expenditures would increase by \$2,500 beginning in fiscal 2002 to pay for the increases in the salaries of board members.
