Judicial Proceedings

Vehicle Laws - Drivers of Vehicles Registered Out of State - Parking Permits

This bill authorizes a local authority, under specified circumstances, to issue a residential parking permit to a property owner in the community in which the person owns property and who is a driver of a vehicle registered in another state.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Since it is assumed that the bill will apply in a limited number of cases, local finances should not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: A local authority may only issue a residential parking permit if the vehicle is registered in the State or if the owner of the vehicle has obtained a nonresident permit or a complimentary guest card.
