**Vehicle Laws - Drivers of Vehicles Registered Out of State - Parking Permits**

---

This bill authorizes a local authority, under specified circumstances, to issue a residential parking permit to a property owner in the community in which the person owns property and who is a driver of a vehicle registered in another state.

---

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** None. Since it is assumed that the bill will apply in a limited number of cases, local finances should not be affected.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

**Analysis**

**Current Law:** A local authority may only issue a residential parking permit if the vehicle is registered in the State or if the owner of the vehicle has obtained a nonresident permit or a complimentary guest card.
