House Bill 258 (Delegate Menes. *et al.*)

Commerce and Government Matters

Vehicle Laws - Parking Lot Requirements - Handicapped Accessible Parking

This bill clarifies that a parking lot that has been painted, repainted, or striped is considered altered for the purposes of conforming with the Maryland Accessibility Code.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill would not affect State finances or operations.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Analysis

Current Law: Parking lots that are altered must conform to the requirements of the Maryland Accessibility Code. The law does not specifically define the term "altered."
