House Bill 728 (Delegate Heller)

## Pedestrian Rights and Rules - Sale or Distribution of Goods or Materials - Prohibition

This bill prohibits a person from selling or distributing, or attempting to sell or distribute, goods or materials to the occupant of a vehicle on a highway within 50 yards of a traffic control signal.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Minimal general fund revenue increase from the penalty provision applicable to this offense under the Maryland Vehicle Law (maximum \$500 fine). Enforcement could be handled with existing resources.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

#### **Analysis**

**Current Law:** A person may not stand in a roadway to solicit a ride, employment, or business from the occupant of a vehicle. Offenders of this provision are subject to a fine of \$50.
