## Frederick County - Crimes - Fire, Rescue, and Ambulance Services

This bill repeals the criminal penalties for providing firefighting, rescue, or ambulance services without the proper authorization from the Frederick County Volunteer Fire and Rescue Association, Inc. and the Frederick County Board of County Commissioners. The civil penalties still apply.

# **Fiscal Summary**

### **Analysis**

**Current Law:** It is unlawful for persons or associations to provide any formally organized firefighting, rescue, or ambulance services without the proper authorization from the Frederick County Volunteer Fire and Rescue Association, Inc. and the Frederick County Board of County Commissioners. A person convicted of the offense is subject to a fine of up to \$1,000 per offense or imprisonment up to six months, or both. A person or association may also be subject to a civil penalty of up to \$2,000, recoverable by the board of county commissioners, and may be enjoined from violating the law.
