## Real Property - Landlord and Tenant - Service of Process

This bill authorizes a constable or sheriff, in an action by a landlord for repossession of premises from a tenant of a multiple unit property, to serve process by affixing a copy of the summons conspicuously on the common area entrance.

### **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: The bill would not substantively change State activities or operations.

**Local Effect:** None. The change is procedural in nature and would not directly affect local government finances.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal.

### **Analysis**

**Current Law:** A constable or sheriff serving process in an action for repossession of premises must affix an attested copy of the summons conspicuously on the property being repossessed.
