Education - Public School Holidays - Presidents' Day

---

This bill establishes Presidents' Day as a public school holiday.

This bill takes effect July 1, 2000.

Fiscal Summary

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Adding an additional holiday to the public school calendar will not alter the number of days that schools are required to remain in session.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

Analysis

**Current Law:** The State has designated several days as public school holidays. They include the following:

- Thanksgiving Day and the day after;
  - Christmas Eve through January 1;
  - Martin Luther King, Jr. Day;
  - Good Friday and Easter Monday;
  - Memorial Day; and
  - Primary and general election days.
