Ways and Means

#### **Chesapeake College - Board of Trustees - Term Limit**

This bill provides that a member of the Board of Trustees of Chesapeake College appointed to begin a term on or after July 1, 2000 may not serve for more than three four-year terms. However, a term of a member that began before July 1, 2000 would not count toward the term limit. In addition, the term of office for the incumbent member representing Dorchester County that is due to expire in 2001 shall expire on July 1, 2002. The term of office for the incumbent member representing Dorchester County that is due to expire in 2003 shall expire on July 1, 2004.

This bill takes effect July 1, 2000.

## **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** None. Providing for term limits for board members would not affect local community college expenditures.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

#### **Analysis**

**Current Law:** The Chesapeake College Board of Trustees consists of two members from each county that supports the college. These counties include Caroline, Dorchester, Kent, Queen's Anne, and Talbot. Board members serve for a term of four years and can be reappointed.
